ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Dr. Andy Toy qualified as a dentist in 1980 from University of Bristol. Since that time, Andy has made himself a devoted student of occlusion. He attended his first course on occlusion in 1982 and attended the L.D.Pankey Institute (USA) later that year. He has since completed all of their Continuum Series, joined their Teaching Faculty and has had a spell on their Advisory Board.

Andy has attended many thousands of hours of Continuing Education associated with occlusion, Temporo-mandibular joint dysfunction and associated areas, such as pain, physical therapy and nutrition.

In 2005 Andy became part of a research group at the world-renowned School of Sport and Exercise Science at Loughborough University. The group has published a number of peer-reviewed papers on the connection between dental occlusion and oral-muscle function.

Andy has successfully applied the principles of posterior-guided, functional occlusion to his own Invisalign practice of over 1000 patients, with many of them reviewed over 5+ years. The patients continue to function happily in comfort with their new smiles and no long-term side-effects.

Andy has been an International Speaker for Align Technology since 2010 and is also Co-Director of the Postgraduate Diploma in Clear Aligner Therapy at the City of London Dental School.
